Settlement Conference at the Assessment Review Board

What is a settlement conference?

A settlement conference is a hearing event before the Assessment Review Board (ARB) where there will be discussions between the parties. At the settlement conference, the ARB Member will assist parties to resolve some or all issues in dispute.

When is a Settlement Conference scheduled?

A settlement conference is scheduled under the schedule of events for a General Proceeding. The ARB will schedule a settlement conference after the parties have filed:

- disclosure
- statement of Issues,
- statement of responses and reply,
- all documentary evidence, witness statements, and
- expert reports.

What if an agreement is not reached at the Settlement Conference?

Sometimes the parties are able to resolve the appeal at the settlement conference. However, if an agreement is not reached, the ARB Member will schedule a full hearing instead.
